

## A NEGATIVE EFFECT BY ADDITIONAL SCREW?

Sometimes clients look for extra (appearance) safety by using an extra screw or similar in addition to the adhesive bond. However, it must be realized that this will counteract the even distribution of load and stress by means of the adhesive bond present.

As a result of the resulting imbalance in stress distribution, both the adhesive bond and the applied locking device will be unevenly loaded, which can locally result in a (too) large force transfer. This in turn will affect and deform the panel material.



Like the shoe umbrella, the use of an additional attachment is not only superfluous but even has a negative effect.

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
