



TWEHA IS WORKING TOWARDS TO A CIRCULAIR ECONOMY

The Dutch construction industry is well known for its innovative ideas. The Netherlands is progressive and always looking for innovative solutions and sustainable techniques. This is also how TWEHA originated in the eighties. In the years since, TWEHA has always remained at the forefront of developments around bonded ventilated façade structures.

Technology is an essential spearhead in these developments. But technology alone is no longer enough. Sustainability is at least as important around 2022. In construction, too, we would like to move towards a circular economy. To achieve this, we need to make more use of sustainable materials and recycle where possible.

We realize that TWEHA's materials only have a limited impact. But we are making every effort - together with our partners, manufacturers of cladding boards and supporting structures and applicators - to initiate a movement towards an integrated building ecosystem.

Just think about reducing the number of sealant tubes. Every year, as many as 2.5 billion pieces (this is 80 times the volume of the Titanic!) end up in the dumpster worldwide. We at TWEHA are doing everything we can to minimize our part in this.
